Removal of PDF mining title maps

Since November 29, 2024, section 60.1 of the Mining Act (chapter M-13.1) has been amended through An Act to amend the Mining Act and other provisions (2024, chapter 36). As a result of this amendment, section 60.1 reads as follows:

60.1. The Minister shall determine the boundaries of the territories in which exclusive exploration rights may be obtained by map designation, and register them in the public register of real and immovable mining rights. The Minister shall, from time to time, modify the boundaries of the territories as and when exclusive exploration rights obtained by staking are map designated or converted into map designated exclusive exploration rights, are not renewed, or are abandoned or revoked.

A log of modifications to the boundaries of the territories in which exclusive exploration rights may be obtained by map designation shall be kept in the register.

The GESTIM interactive map is now the method for disseminating Québec's public register of real and immovable mining rights.

As of December 10, 2025, mining title maps in PDF format will no longer be produced and disseminated on the GESTIM document release site (formerly the GESTIM FTP site).

The GESTIM interactive map offers its users the possibility of displaying the desired layers of mining titles, as well as constraints on mining activity and a number of other information related to Québec mining.

A geometric and descriptive data set for mining titles, constraints related to mining activity, surface mineral extraction sites, etc. is made available to clients on the [GESTIM document release site](#). This data is updated every Monday and is available in MapInfo and Shapefile formats. The user of these data can integrate them into geomatics software to create their own mining title map.
