Congress organizers reserve the right to refuse exhibitors who do not comply with the guidelines. Some elements of this guide may be revised or modified at any time (the date at the bottom of this page is proof of the latest version).

The scientific exhibition brings together professionals and researchers from the Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles, the Geological Survey of Canada, various geological and scientific research facilities, as well as university students and prospectors who wish to present the latest research results. This guide provides you with all the information you need to prepare your paper or electronic poster to experience this exceptional exhibition.

DÉFI DE LA RECHERCHE EN GÉOSCIENCES

Each year, as part of the Québec Mines + Énergie congress, we offer university students a contest to present a geoscientific poster in the exhibition hall, which is the Défi de la Recherche en géosciences. Scholarships are offered to winners, four to graduate students (doctoral and master's) and one to a bachelor's student.

Level	Prize
Doctorate 1 st prize	\$2,000
Doctorate 2 nd prize	\$700
Master's 1 st prize	\$1,500
Master's 2 nd prize	\$500
Bachelor's	\$300

Note that due to the increasing number of participants, a **pre-selection will be made based on the 400-word summary** for the Master's and Doctorate. For the selected students, it will be important, in addition to the poster, to prepare a 5-minute PowerPoint for a **public presentation open to all congress participants on Tuesday, November 22 in the morning**. If your poster is selected for a presentation, you will be notified by October 28, 2022. Details regarding the location and format of the presentation will be shared in the weeks leading up to the congress.

EXHIBITION

The Québec Mines + Énergie 2022 scientific exhibition will take place in Room 400 of the Centre des congrès de Québec

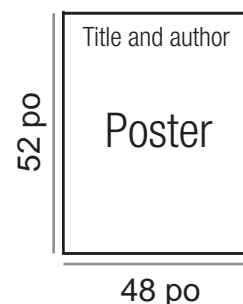
Paper posters will have to be 52" high x 48" wide.

Poster support structures and a 4' long by 18" deep table in front of each poster will be provided.

As the posters will be installed one next to the other, no overflow will be tolerated.

Containers or boxes used to transport equipment shall be identified and stored in a designated area.

Organizers reserve the right to group exhibitors according to their profile and the subject of their poster.



The title and authors must be written at the top of the poster.

Scientific posters must be on display for the duration of the congress. Delays and absences without reasons deemed valid will result in a rejection of applications for future years.

Exhibitors **must provide** velcro for display of their paper poster. Plan for 1 metre of male velcro (hooks).

Safety

Exhibitors have access to the exhibition hall starting at 8:30 a.m. for all three days of the congress.

The exhibition rooms are monitored at all times. However, the Centre des congrès de Québec and the organizers of Québec Mines + Énergie 2022 are in no way responsible for any loss, theft or property damage or injury sustained by anyone at the congress.

Space reservation

In order to reserve a space, you must complete the attached form and return it no later than **October 7, 2022**. The first author is entitled to a free conference and exhibition pass for the duration of the congress.

Scientific summary

Exhibitors must submit a summary of their poster. These will be displayed, in French, on the Québec Mines + Énergie 2022 website and in the Summary of conferences and posters document. For summaries submitted in English, translation will be carried out by the organizing committee.

- Language: French
- Recommended software: Microsoft® Word (format *.doc)
- Font: Times New Roman, 10 pts
- Text: full page, 8½ x 11 (avoid column text)
- Number of words: 400 words maximum

Word count: To know the exact number of words in a summary, we suggest you use the Microsoft® Word Statistics tool. Note that the title, list of authors and acronyms are not counted in the 400-word summary.

Matching titles

The author must ensure that the title previously provided matches the title that accompanies the summary.

Authors

authors' first and last names are followed, in parentheses, by the name of the affiliation or, preferably, its acronym.

Example

James Moorhead, Jean-Yves Labbé (MERN), Michel Jébrak (UQAM), Jean H. Bédard and Pierre Brouillette (GSC-Q)

Acronyms

If an acronym is used to indicate an affiliation, its meaning (full name of the affiliation) must be written at the end of the summary.

Examples

GSC-Q: Geological Survey of Canada, Québec

MERN: Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles

UQAM: Université du Québec à Montréal

University scholarships – Graduate students

The contest is open to graduate students at the Master's (M.Sc.) and Doctorate (Ph.D.) level at a Québec university or a university outside Québec. Field work must be carried out in Québec and the subject of the dissertation or thesis must be related to Québec. Post-doctoral students are not eligible.

Participants are encouraged to display their posters in French. However, English posters are accepted.
